2021 MOUNTAIN CUVEE

A Bordeaux-Obsessed Blend from Sonoma County

TASTING NOTES: Our Mountain Cuvée is a Bordeaux-obsessed blend featuring layer upon layer of ripe fruit - think boysenberry, cranberry and pomegranate - followed by a hint of toasty oak. This medium-bodied red blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cab Franc and Malbec is packed with juicy red fruit, black currants and a dark chocolate finish. We're getting silky tannins. Hints of oak and cedar. And, an elegant structure with a finish that's a real crowd-pleaser. Enjoy it on its own or paired up with something as perfectly unassuming as the wine (we especially love it with backyard burgers).

FROM DIRT TO BOTTLE: Relying on the Bundschu Family's 160+ years of Sonoma vineyard knowledge, the grapes for Mountain Cuvée are sourced from our Rhinefarm estate as well as fruit hand-selected from vineyards along the Mayacamas Mountain range to strike that perfect balance between fruit, tannin and acid. We source only from sustainable growers, with our primary vineyards coming from within 2 miles of our estate. This method allows us to get to know the vineyard and find the best way to approach it in the winery. During the winemaking process, we blend vineyard blocks together, evaluate, and then create an oak program to place the finishing touches on the wine. We call this managing the wine from dirt to bottle.

THE BLEND: 57% Cabernet Sauvignon, 39% Merlot, 2% Cabernet Franc, 2% Malbec
